## EASY KNITTING PATTERN

# Bunting Flags

## Five different designs.

Each bunting flag measures approximately 12cm across the top & 10cm in length.

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## **Materials Required**

Single point knitting needles

3.75mm / US size 5

DK yarn - approx 5g per flag

Images use Robin Double Knit 100% Acrylic

String, cord or ribbon to thread thorough flags
Darning needle & scissors

## **Abbreviations**

 $\mathbf{K} = \text{knit stitch}$ 

**K10** = knit 10 stitches

 $\mathbf{P}$  = purl stitch

**P10** = purl 10 stitches

**YO** = yarn over

 $\mathbf{CO} = \mathrm{cast} \ \mathrm{off}$ 

**CO1** = cast off 1 stitch

## Safety

Be aware of risk of strangulation.

This bunting is not a toy.

Do not hang the bunting within reach of children.

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## Garter stitch with border

Cast on 25 stitches.

## Knitting the threading holes:

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: [K2tog, YO] repeat to last 3 stitches,

K2tog (no YO), K1 (24 stitches)

Row 3: Knit

Row 4: Knit

## Knitting the triangle:

Row 5:

Knit 4

CO1 (from stitches just knitted)

Knit to last 2 stitches

CO1 (from stitches just knitted)

Knit 2 (22 stitches)

Row 6: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2

Row 7: Knit

Row 8: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2

Row 9 \*: K4, CO1, knit to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (20 stitches)

Row 10: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2

Row 11: Knit

Row 12: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2

Row 13 \*: K4, CO1, knit to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (18 stitches)

Row 14: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2

Row 15: Knit

Row 16: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2

Row 17 \*: K4, CO1, knit to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (16 stitches)

Row 18: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2

Row 19: Knit

Row 20: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2



Row 21 \*: K4, CO1, knit to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (14 stitches)

Row 22: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2

Row 23: Knit

Row 24: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2

Row 25 \*: K4, CO1, knit to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (12 stitches)

Row 26: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2

Row 27: Knit

Row 28: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2

Row 29 \*: K4, CO1, knit to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (10 stitches)

Row 30: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2

Row 31: Knit

Row 32: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2

Row 33 \*: K4. CO1. knit to last 2 stitches. CO1. K2 (8 stitches)

Row 34: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2

Row 35: Knit

Row 36: P2, knit to last 2 stitches, P2

## Finishing the point:

Row 37 \*: K4, CO1, knit to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (6 stitches)

**Row 38:** P2. K2. P2

**Row 39:** K3, CO1, K2, CO1, K1 (4 stitches)

**Row 40:** P1, K2, P1

Row 41: K2, CO1, K2, CO1 (2 stitches)

Row 42: K2, CO1 (1 stitch)

Cut yarn and pull through last stitch.

Use yarn tail to fasten bead or charm onto the point of the flag, or make yarn secure and weave yarn tails into knitting to finish.

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## Andalusian stitch

Cast on 25 stitches.

## Knitting the threading holes:

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: [K2tog, YO] repeat until 3 stitches remain, K2tog (no YO), K1 (24 stitches)

Row 3: Knit Row 4: Knit

### Knitting the triangle:

Row 5: Knit 4

CO1 (from stitches just knitted)

Knit to last 2 stitches

CO1 (from stitches just knitted)

Knit 2 (22 stitches)

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: [K1, P1] repeat to end of row

Row 8: Purl

Row 9: K4, CO1, Knit to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (20 stitches)

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: [P1, K1] repeat to end of row

Row 12: Purl

Row 13: K4, CO1, Knit to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (18 stitches)

Row 14: Purl

Row 15: [K1, P1] repeat to end of row

Row 16: Purl

Row 17: K4, CO1, Knit to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (16 stitches)

Row 18: Purl

Row 19: [P1, K1] repeat to end of row

Row 20: Purl



Row 21: K4, CO1, Knit to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (14 stitches)

Row 22: Purl

Row 23: [K1, P1] repeat to end of row

Row 24: Purl

Row 25: K4, CO1, Knit to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (12 stitches)

Row 26: Purl

Row 27: [P1, K1] repeat to end of row

Row 28: Purl

Row 29: K4, CO1, Knit to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (10 stitches)

Row 30: Purl

Row 31: [K1, P1] repeat to end of row

Row 32: Purl

Row 33: K4, CO1, Knit to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (8 stitches)

Row 34: Purl

Row 35: [P1, K1] repeat to end of row

Row 36: Purl

## Finishing the point:

Row 37: K4, CO1, Knit to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (6 stitches)

Row 38: Purl

Row 39: K3, CO1, K2, CO1, K1 (4 stitches)

Row 40: Purl

Row 41: K2, CO1, K2, CO1 (2 stitches)

Row 42: K2, CO1 (1 stitch)

Cut yarn tail and thread through loop to finish.

Use yarn tail to fasten bead or charm onto the point of the flag, or make yarn secure and weave yarn tails into knitting to finish.

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## Horizontal stripes

**N.B** This flag tends to curl up - it is best made with a bead or charm threaded onto the yarn at the point of the flag, which helps to hold it straight.

Cast on 25 stitches.

## Knitting the threading holes:

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: [K2tog, YO] repeat to last 3 stitches,

K2tog (no YO), K1 (24 stitches)

Row 4: Knit

## Knitting the triangle:

Row 5: Purl 4

CO1 from stitches just worked

Purl to last 2 stitches

CO1 from stitches just worked,

Purl 2 (22 stitches)

Row 6: Knit.

Row 7: Purl

Row 8: Knit

Row 9: P4, CO1, P until 2 stitches remain, CO1, P2 (20 stitches)

Row 10: Knit

Row 11: Purl

Row 12: Knit

Row 13: K4, CO1, K to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (18 stitches)

Row 14: Purl

Row 15: Knit

Row 16: Purl

Row 17: K4, CO1, K to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (16 stitches)

Row 18: Purl

Row 19: Knit

Row 20: Purl



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Row 21: P4, CO1, P to last 2 stitches, CO1, P2 (14 stitches)
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Row 22: Knit

Row 23: Purl

Row 24: Knit

Row 25: P4, CO1, P to last 2 stitches, CO1, P2 (12 stitches)

Row 26: Knit

Row 27: Purl

Row 28: Knit

Row 29: K4, CO1, K to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (10 stitches)

Row 30: Purl

Row 31: Knit

Row 32: Purl

Row 33: K4, CO1, K to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (8 stitches)

Row 34: Purl

Row 35: Knit

Row 36: Purl

## Finishing the point:

Row 37: P4. CO1. P to last 2 stitches. CO1. P2 (6 stitches)

Row 38: Knit

Row 39: P3, CO1, P2, CO1, P1 (4 stitches)

Row 40: Knit

Row 41: P2, CO1, P2, CO1 (2 stitches)

**Row 42:** K2, CO1 (1 stitch)

Cut yarn and pull through loop to finish

Use yarn tail to fasten bead or charm onto the point of the flag, or make yarn secure and weave yarn tails into knitting to finish.

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## Double moss stitch with border

Cast on 25 stitches

## Knitting the threading holes:

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: [K2tog, YO] repeat until 3 stitches remain,

K2tog (no YO), K1 (24 stitches)

Row 3: Knit Row 4: Knit

## Knitting the triangle:

Row 5: Knit 3. Purl 1.

CO1 from stitches just worked, Purl 1,

[Knit 2, Purl 2] repeat to last 3 stitches,

Knit 1, CO1 from stitches just worked,

Knit 2 (22 stitches)

Row 6: [P2, K2] repeat to end

Row 7: K4, [P2, K2] repeat to last 4 stitches, K4

Row 8: P4, [K2, P2] repeat to last 4 stitches, P4

Row 9: K2, P2, CO1, [K2, P2] repeat to last 2 stitches, CO1 K2

Row 10: P2, K1, [P2, K2] repeat to last 3 stitches, K1, P2

Row 11: K3, [P2, K2] repeat to last 3 stitches, K3

Row 12: P3, [K2, P2] repeat to last 3 stitches, P3

Row 13: K2, P1, K1, CO1, K1 [P2, K2] repeat to last 3 stitches,

P1, CO1, K2 (18 stitches)

Row 14: P4, [K2, P2] repeat to last 2 stitches, P2

Row 15: [K2, P2] repeat to end

Row 16: [P2, K2] repeat to end

Row 17: K4, CO1, [P2, K2] repeat to last 2 stitches, CO1, K2 (16 stitches)

Row 18: P3, [K2, P2] repeat to last 3 stitches, P3

Row 19: K2, P1, [K2, P2] repeat to last 3 stitches, P1, K2

Row 20: P2, K1, [P2, K2] repeat to last 3 stitches, K1, P2



**Row 21:** K3, P1, CO1, P1, [K2, P2] repeat to last 3 stitches, K1, CO1, K2 (14 stitches)

Row 22: [P2, K2] repeat to end

Row 23: K4, P2, K2, P2, K4

Row 24: P4, K2, P2, K2, P4

Row 25: K2, P2, CO1, K2, P2, K2, P2, CO1, K2 (12 stitches)

**Row 26:** P2, K1, P2, K2, P2, K1, P2

Row 27: K3, P2, K2, P2, K3

Row 28: P3, K2, P2, K2, P3

Row 29: K2, P1, K1, CO1, K1, P2, K2, P1, CO1, K2 (10 stitches)

Row 30: P4. K2. P4

Row 31: [K2, P2] repeat to end

Row 32: [P2, K2] repeat to end

Row 33: K4, CO1, P2, K2, CO1, K2 (8 stitches)

**Row 34:** P3, K2, P3

**Row 35:** K2, P1, K2, P1, K2

**Row 36:** P2, K1, P2, K1, P2

## Finishing the point:

Row 37: K3, P1, CO1, P1, K1, CO1, K2 (6 stitches)

**Row 38**: P2, K2, P2

**Row 39:** K3, CO1, K2, CO1, K1 (4 stitches)

**Row 40:** P4

Row 41: K2, CO1, K2, CO1 (2 stitches)

Row 42: K2, CO1 (1 stitch)

Cut yarn and pull through loop.

Use yarn tail to fasten bead or charm onto the point of the flag, or make yarn secure and weave yarn tails into knitting to finish.

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## Basket stitch with border

Cast on 25 stitches.

## Knitting the threading holes:

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: [K2tog, YO] repeat until 3 stitches remain,

K2tog (no YO), K1 (24 stitches

Row 3: Knit

Row 4: Knit.

## Knitting the triangle:

Row 5: Knit 2, Purl 2,

CO1 from stitches just worked,

Purl 1,

Knit 4, Purl 4, Knit 4, Purl 4,

Knit 1, CO1 from stitches just worked, Knit 2 (22 stitches)

**Row 6:** P2, K4, P4, K4, P4, K2, P2

**Row 7:** K2, P2, K4, P4, K4, P4, K2

Row 8: repeat row 6

Row 9: K2, P2, CO1, K4, P4, K4, P4, CO1, K2 (20 stitches)

Row 10: P2. K3. P4. K4. P4. K1. P2.

Row 11: K2, P1, K4, P4, K4, P3, K2

Row 12: repeat row 10

Row 13: K3, P1, CO1, P3, K4, P4, K3, CO1, K2 (18 stitches)

**Row 14:** P4, K4, P4, K4, P2

**Row 15:** K2, P4, K4, P4, K4

Row 16: repeat row 14

Row 17: K2, P2, CO1, P2, K4, P4, K2, CO1, K2 (16 stitches)

**Row 18:** P3. K4. P4. K3. P2

Row 19: K2, P3, K4, P4, K3

Row 20: repeat row 18



Row 21: K4, CO1, K1, P4, K4, P1, CO1, K2 (14 stitches)

**Row 22:** P6, K4, P4

Row 23: K4, P4, K6

Row 24: repeat row 22

Row 25: K4, CO1, P4, K4, CO1, K2 (12 stitches)

**Row 26:** P5, K4, P3

**Row 27:** K3, P4, K5

Row 28: repeat row 26

Row 29: K2, P1, K1, CO1, K3, P3, CO1, K2 (10 stitches)

**Row 30:** P2, K2, P6

**Row 31:** K6, P2, K2

Row 32: repeat row 30

Row 33: K4, CO1, K2, P2, CO1, K2 (8 stitches)

**Row 34:** P2, K1, P5

**Row 35:** K5, P1, K2

Row 36: repeat row 34

## Finishing the point:

Row 37: K2, P2, CO1, P1, K1, CO1, K2 (6 stitches)

**Row 38:** P2, K2, P2

Row 39: K2, P1, CO1, P1, K1, CO1, K1 (4 stitches)

**Row 40:** P4

Row 41: K2, CO1, K2, CO1 (2 stitches)

Row 42: P2, CO1 (1 stitch)

Cut yarn and pull through loop.

Use yarn tail to fasten bead or charm onto the point of the flag, or make yarn secure and weave yarn tails into knitting to finish.

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
